2018: Year Of The Starfish

For the Chinese and in many parts of Asia, 2018 is the year of the dog. But for All Nations, this is the Year of the Starfish. The starfish is a most amazing creature. If you cut a starfish in half, it does not die. It is not incapacitated or limbless. Instead, it multiplies into two starfish. For the long-armed Linckia starfish, a new starfish can be birthed out of just one arm, and multiple new starfish can be birthed out of multiple parts of the same starfish.¹ A starfish exists to regenerate and multiply and keep multiplying. **For All Nations, 2018 is the Year of the Starfish because it is the Year of Multiplication.**

This year, All Nations plans to multiply catalytic hubs which train and send workers to the unreached peoples and places to multiply disciples, leaders, and church planting movements. All Nations currently has two hubs in Kansas City and Cape Town that have trained and sent most of our workers in 41 countries. But God has called All Nations to not only grow these hubs but to strategically multiply catalytic hubs in gateway cities in the key regions of the world. **In 2018, we will be launching 2 more hubs in Hamburg, Germany, Europe and Kampala, Uganda, East Africa**, where All Nations already has exponential church planting in both locations. In Hamburg, Germany, we have baptized more than 250 Muslim-background believers and established a Farsi-speaking church in the past year. The Germany hub will focus on church planting among the Muslim refugee populations in 50 key cities in Europe. In Kampala, we have established 417 house churches in the ghetto and Muslim outskirts. The Kampala hub will focus on mobilizing workers from eastern Africa to the surrounding nations and beyond. **Our goal is by 2025 to have a total of 10 hubs in global gateway cities that will mobilize, train, and send workers from every nation to every nation.** All Nations International exists to serve all the people of our global family in every hub, church, and location.

Jesus is calling workers from everywhere to everywhere. About 78% of the world's global mission force is now from Africa, Asia, the Middle East, and Latin America. By multiplying hubs around the world, All Nations can mobilize American, African, Asian, Middle Eastern, and Latin American workers to be part of finishing the Great Commission in this generation so that **every man, woman, and child in every place among every people will have the opportunity to know, love, and worship Jesus for all eternity.**

- **Healthcare** - building the Murundu Mission Hospital of Hope in a community where the closest healthcare access is a 2-hour walk.
- **Family Support/Education** -18 families are supported to receive food and basic needs, an after-school program that teaches English, reading, writing, Bible stories and life skills, and a women's empowerment program of sewing, crafts and discipleship;
- **Discipleship/Prayer** - There are currently 13 discipleship groups going each week, weekly evangelism, prayer, and outreach in the villages and preaching/teaching;
- **Sustainability** - The current farm has cabbages, tomatoes, corn, onions, green peppers, lettuce, and eggplant. The fruit orchard has lemons, oranges, guava, avocados, mangoes, and bananas! Future plans include a green shop, restaurant, and teaching skills that go along with this project.
